ASSESSMENT AND TREATMENT

Referrals of children, adolescents and adults to the Centre's practising psychoanalysts are welcome.

The Centre has a firm commitment to the principle of inclusion. Limited ability to pay will not preclude individuals from being offered treatment.

Fees are not set by the Centre: they will be negotiated directly between analyst and patient.

If you anticipate difficulty with payment or are only wanting an initial interview, please mention this at the time of calling, so referral can be made to a suitable vacancy within our accessible psychoanalysis initiative. There may be a limit to the number of places in this program, but every attempt will be made to accommodate specific needs.

SUPERVISION AND SECONDARY CONSULTATIONS

As well as providing referrals to practising psychoanalysts, the service can refer individual practitioners and groups in the mental health sector to supervision and consultation services.

TRAINING AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

The ACP:
