

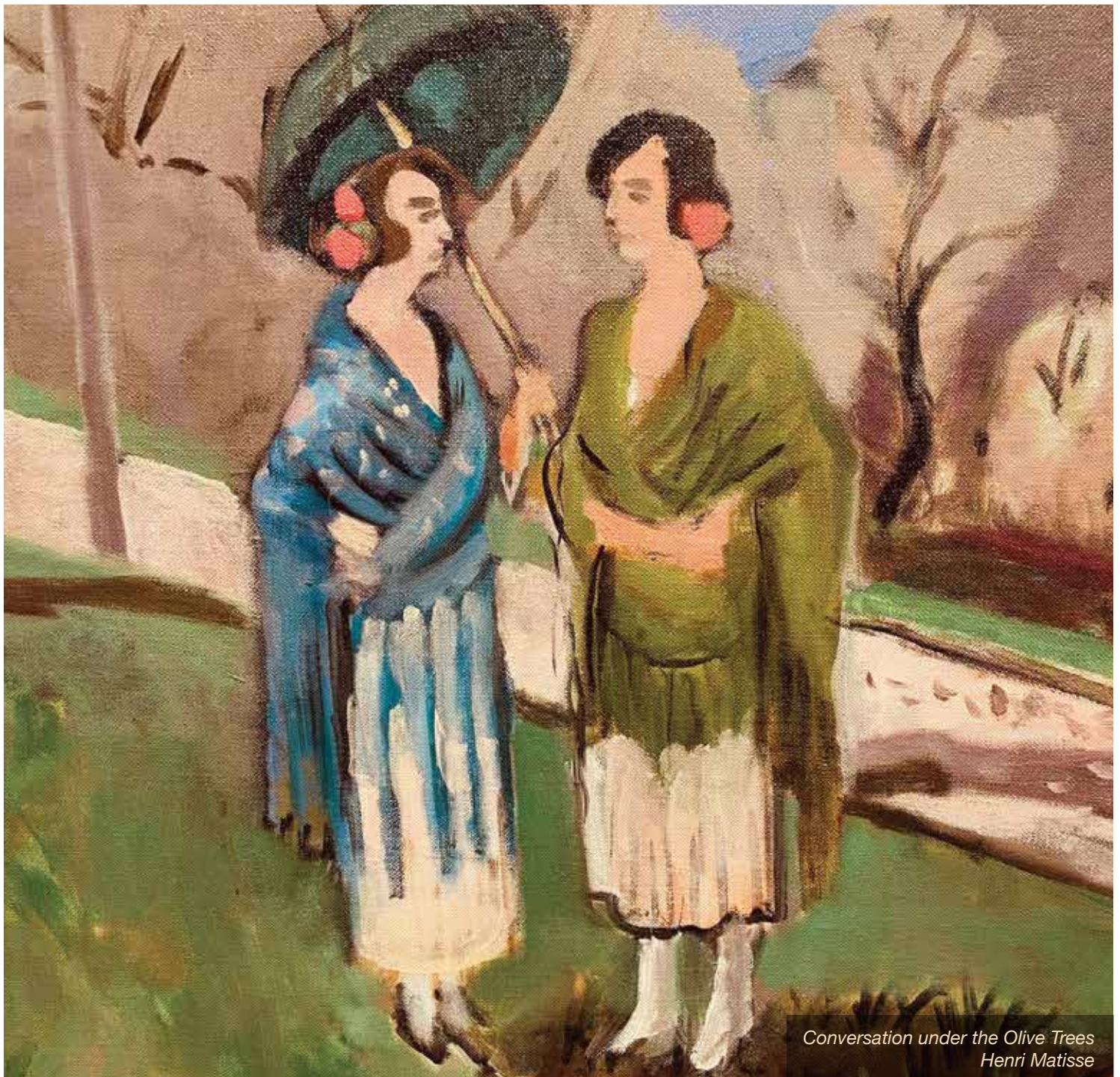

Lacan added gaze and voice to Freud's list of drive objects.

This seminar will examine the Freudian references that led Lacan to isolate the voice as an object at the heart of the Other's speech, without however being able to respond to it. We will then examine the place of this object in the structure of language from the perspective of Borromean theory. We will then deduce the clinical consequences.



Dr Bernard Nominé is a psychoanalyst and psychiatrist from Pau, France. He is an Analyst Member of the School of Psychoanalysis of the Forums of the Lacanian Field and teaches at the Clinical Colleges of the South-West of France and internationally. He has written extensively on psychoanalytic theory and practice.
